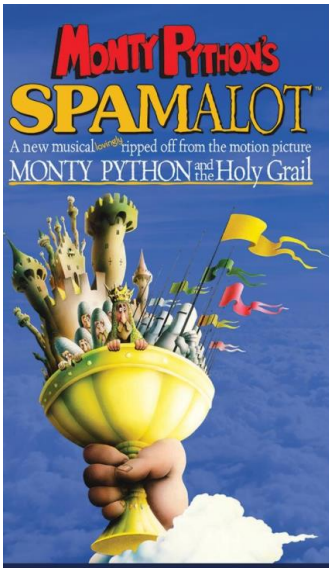
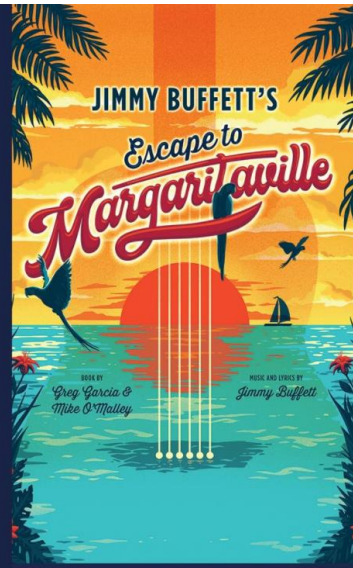


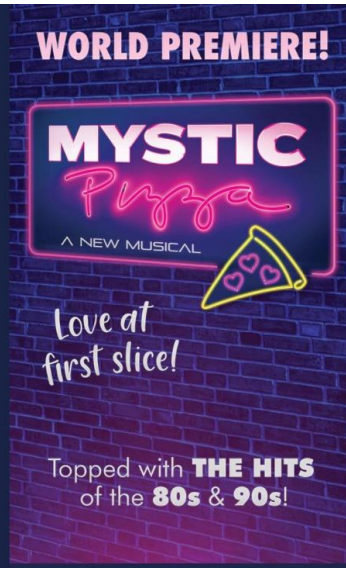

Monty Python's Spamalot tells the legendary tale of King Arthur's quest to find the Holy Grail. Inspired by the classic comedy film, *Monty Python and the Holy Grail*, the musical also diverts a bit from more traditional versions of the legend. The original 2005 Broadway production received 14 Tony Award nominations, winning in three categories, including Best Musical.
